MS. RENN REPORTED FOR THE WATER DEPARTMENT: NO OVERTIME. ASSISTED THE LINEGANG WITH ELECTRICAL LINE WEST OF TOWN; ASSISTED SHERIFF WITH BACKHOE TO DIG UP YARD LOOKING FOR ITEMS AT 916 LINDELL ST.; JETTING SEWER MAIN; RADIO BEING INSTALLED IN NEW JET TRUCK; WAITING ON TITLE FOR NEW JET TRUCK; TURNED WATER FILTRATION PLANT BACK ON MONDAY; WATER USAGE FOR LAST WEEK WAS 790,000 GAL/DAY.
