UNDER DEPARTMENT HEAD REPORTS: ELECTRICAL DEPARTMENT SUPERINTENDENT JIM MOREHEAD REPORTED ONE OVERTIME DUE TO A BAD CONNECTOR AT A RESIDENCE. WORK ON THE 3<sup>RD</sup> ST. TRANSFORMER BY SOLOMON IS SCHEDULED FOR APRIL 27 – MAY 4 PERIOD; WORK AT BRICKYARD CONTINUING; SAND PIT POWER UPGRADE ON HOLD PENDING FURTHER DESIGN; ALL ELECTRICAL TRENCHING COMPLETED TO PEDESTALS AT CRYSTAL SPRINGS; NEW STOREKEEPER HAS REPORTED TO WORK; MOVING OVERHEAD POWER LINES TO UNDERGROUND AT RESIDENCES AROUND CRYSTAL SPRINGS; REPLACING OLD POWER POLES; ADDING LIGHT POLES AT CRYSTAL SPRINGS; CUTTING TREES; DISCONNECTS TO HOUSES SCHEDULED FOR DEMO. WATER SUPERINTENDENT JEFF SWEETSER REPORTED ONE OVERTIME DUE TO WATER MAIN BRAKE AT SOUTH J ST. TAKING LEAD/COPPER SAMPLES; DISCONNECTING UTILITY FROM 125 W. 4<sup>TH</sup> AND 1205 D ST. SCHEDULED FOR DEMO; CHANGED PREFILTERS AGAIN AT WATER FILTRATION PLANT – SAMPLES OF CONTAMINATES SENT TO LABORATORY FOR IDENTIFICATION; REPAIRED IRRIGATION LINES AT SOFTBALL FIELD; RESIDENTIAL SERVICE LINE LEAKS AT 109 5<sup>TH</sup> ST. AND 706 E ST.; WILL BE TAKING NITRATE AND MAGNESIUM SAMPLES; WATER USAGE FOR THE PREVIOUS WEEK WAS 980,000 GAL/DAY.

CITY ADMINISTRATOR MS. RENN DISTRIBUTED FOR BOARD CONSIDERATION A LETTER OF AGREEMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES WITH OLSSON ASSOCIATES FOR WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT EDA PRELIMINARY REPORT. TELECON WITH CRAIG REINSCH OF OLSSON ASSOCIATES WHO SUMMARIZED THE ESSENCE OF THE REPORT. AFTER DISCUSSION, THE BOARD RECOMMENDED NOT TO PROCEED WITH THIS PROJECT WITH FINAL DETERMINATION TO BE MADE BY CITY COUNCIL.

MS. RENN PRESENTED AN AERIAL VIEW OF THE SAND PIT IN RELATION TO THE WELLS AT CRYSTAL SPRINGS. AERIAL SHOWS PIT OPERATIONS WITHIN 513 FEET OF THE WELLS. THE SAND PIT OPERATIONS HAD BEEN OF CONCERN PREVIOUSLY AND PIT OPERATORS HAD INDICATED THEY WOULD MOVE OPERATIONS TO THE WEST BUT THIS IS NOT OCCURRING AS INDICATED BY THE AERIALS. BOARD CONCERNS FOR THE SAFETY OF OUR WATER SUPPLY AND WHETHER OR NOT THESE OPERATIONS HAVE IMPACT ON THE FILTRATION ISSUES WE ARE EXPERIENCING.

MS. RENN REPORTED THE STORMWATER/WATER PROJECT IS ON HOLD DUE TO THE CORONAVIRUS OUTBREAK; DISCUSSED DISCONNECT PROCEDURES.

MS. RENN REVIEWED FINANCES WITH THE BOARD. OUTSTANDING ACCOUNTS WERE PRESENTED.

THERE BEING NO FURTHER BUSINESS THE MEETING WAS ADJOURNED AT 09:52 A.M.
