DISCUSSED ISSUE WITH SIDE-BY-SIDE SPRAYER AND BOARD APPROVED RENTING THE EQUIPMENT FOR ONE MONTH AT \$550.00/MO, 2ND MONTH AT \$450.00. WATER SUPERINTENDENT JEFF SWEETSER REPORTED NO OVERTIME. WATER SERVICE ISSUES AT 103 7TH ST. AND 904 A ST.; CONCRETING VALVE BOXES; JETTING SEWER MAINS; TAKING LEAD/COPPER SAMPLES; SMOOTHING PADS AND INSTALLING WATER TO PEDESTALS AT CRYSTAL SPRINGS; LEVELING OF GROUNDS AT CRYSTAL SPRINGS FOR GROUNDS TO RESEED; NITRATE SAMPLES TAKEN ARE AS FOLLOWS:

MS. RENN PRESENTED THE BOARD WITH A MEMORANDUM PRESENTING AN ANALYSIS OF FIRST QUARTER POWER CONSUMPTION FOR THE PERIOD OF 2018-2020. 1Q 2020 CONSUMPTION IS DOWN APPROXIMATELY 6% FROM 1Q 2019 FOR ALL CATAGORIES OF USERS.

MS. RENN REPORTED THE WATER AGREEMENT WITH KEYSTONE PIPELINE HAS BEEN SENT TO KEYSTONE; THE NMPP SOLAR PROJECT INFORMATION TO THE CITY COUNCIL FOR REVIEW.
