UNDER DEPARTMENT HEAD REPORTS: WATER SUPERINTENDENT JEFF SWEETSER REPORTED OVERTIMES FOR REWORKING WATER MAIN BREAK ON THIRD STREET ST. DUE TO CONSTRUCTION OF THE NEW STORM WATER SYSTEM. SERVICE LINE BREAK AT 924 A ST.; RECEIVING CHEMICAL THIS WEEK FOR THE TREATMENT OF THE BIOFILM AT THE WATER TREATMENT PLANT – MAY BE A PRODUCT DELIVERY PROBLEM DUE TO THE VOLUME OF CHEMICAL NEEDED ON A DAILY BASIS PER REQUIREMENTS OF ENGINEER (15-30 GAL/DAY); WORKING ON CHANGING THE NAME ON USER/REPORTS DUE TO CHANGE IN SEWER PLANT OPERATOR; GREASE IS REMAINING A PROBLEM FLOWING TO THE SEWER TREATMENT PLANT – CONTINUING TO MONITOR TO FIND PROBLEM; WATER USEAGE FOR THE PREVIOUS WEEK WAS 1, 439,000 GAL/DAY.

MS. RENN PRESENTED TO THE BOARD (15) PENDING WORK ORDERS FOR REVIEW AND APPROVAL.

MS. RENN REPORTED THAT THERE WERE NUMEROUS POWER OUTAGES IN FAIRBURY AND SURROUNDING COMMUNITIES DUE TO SEVERE STORM THAT PASSED THROUGH THE AREA LAST WEEK; CONTINUING TO WORK ON CONTRACT WITH WINDSTREAM AND OTHER COMMUNICATION CONTRACTS.

MS. RENN REVIEWED FINANCES WITH THE BOARD. OUTSTANDING ACCOUNTS WERE PRESENTED.

THERE BEING NO FURTHER BUSINESS THE MEETING WAS ADJOURNED AT 09:10 A.M.
